Alphapointe Association for the Blind empowers people with vision loss to maximize their independence.

Since 1911, Alphapointe has provided training and jobs for

the visually impaired in the Kansas City metropolitan area. As the only provider of Comprehensive Vision Rehabilitation in the state of Missouri, Alphapointe provides critical services for working age adults 16 and older. Alphapointe's Comprehensive Rehabilitation Services(CRS) and Education Program enhances independence, productivity and quality of life for Missouri's adults, youth and seniors who have recently lost their vision, been blind since birth or whose sight is endangered, regardless of their ability to pay.

Alphapointe's critical job training services are available to over 80,000 legally blind and visually impaired individuals in the Kansas City area. These services provide a means for economic stability, job creation and development for the visually impaired. Preparing blind and visually impaired individuals for and positioning them in employment is the core component of this program. Employment is the most empowering tool to change an individual's life, make them financially independent and integrating them into the community. The program outcomes focus on the goals of the clients and reinforce the need for independent living skills as a measure of self-sufficiency. Financial independence is the goal of employment for all CRS clients.

In addition to the employment training program, the focus of Alphapointe's Senior Adult Services is on the health, safety and well-being of visually impaired seniors. This program promotes self-sufficiency for seniors by teaching new skills that enable older adults to remain in their homes, maintain active lifestyles and stay committed to their families and communities.
