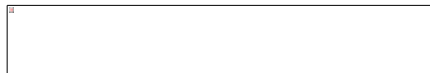

Thousands Turnout for Organization's Annual Walk

ON THE MOVE to end Alzheimer's, more than 2,600 walkers and approximately 120 volunteers participated in the Alzheimer's Association-Heart of America Chapter's annual "Memory Walk" on Saturday, October 4th in memory of those who lost their battle with the incurable disease.

"We had a record year for Memory Walk; far-surpassing our goal," said Jan Horn, Community Relations Coordinator. "So far, (the money is still coming in) we have recorded over \$332,000 and will be collecting through the end of the year, so it's not too late to make a donation."

Raising awareness and funds for Alzheimer prevention methods, treatments and an eventual cure, the organization's "Memory Walk" is the largest national event held in an effort to fight the fatal disease.

In nearly 20 years, the "Memory Walk" has raised more than \$230 million for the cause and been the Association's signature event for awareness and fundraising.

"We are so thankful for the success of this event, and continue to hope for a cure soon," said Horn.

The Alzheimer's Association is the leading voluntary health organization in Alzheimer care, support and research.

"When Alzheimer's disease touches a life, the Alzheimer's Association is here to help," said Horn. "The Heart of America Chapter is the trusted resource for much needed information,

education, training and support to more than 250,000 people in our 66-county service area suffering the emotional, physical and financial challenges of Alzheimer's disease."

More than 5 million people in the United States are living with Alzheimer's today and with more than 78 million baby boomers turning 60 this year, the potential of this disease can increase each year.

Currently, there is no cure for this disease, but new treatments are on the horizon. This disease crosses all communities, and education and income levels. Researchers anticipate more than 7.7 million people 65 years and older will be affected by 2030.
