"When you give a girl a chance to thrive, you're literally changing the world. How? It's called the 'Girl Effect'," says Executive Director and Founder Mary Beth Gentry. "When girls finish high school they boost their eventual wages by twenty-five percent, finishing college is fifty percent."

An alarming number of young girls in Kansas City's urban core are in a perilous position. They are at great risk of leading lives characterized by violence, mental illness and hopelessness. Without resiliency and self-efficacy, they will continue to repeat the ongoing cycle they were born into at great cost to society. Without an affirming belief system, proper knowledge and skills, their potential contribution to society will be lost.

Young Women on the Move is on a mission to help these girls claim their personal power, become healthy in mind, body and spirit, and develop the skills to become healthy, emotionally resilient, and capable adults.

YWOA's year-round programs give girls ideal opportunities to build caring relationships with peer, staff and volunteers while pursuing personal goals to reach their full potential.

Program components include:

- Character Development
- Competency-based Life Skills
- Health Assessments and Follow-up
- Partnering with Parents
- Weekly In- and After-school Meetings
- Service Learning
- Peer Mentoring
- Recognitions of Success
- Pathways to Excellence

The comprehensive health and life skills program instills a foundation of moral values, character, and an affirming self-belief system.

Girls receive tools to increase knowledge and skills in decision making and problem solving, physical and mental health, social competency, communication skills, academic and career preparation.

Each girl receives individualized support and reinforcement through professional case management, mentoring, team building, goal setting, and accountability.
